This document is a report of the International English Library's item checkouts and membership for the year 2025, including also historical graphs.

The data for this report was exported from the library's catalogue management system Koha. The library has been using Koha only since 2016, therefore anything before does not represent the library's historical checkout data.

The library was closed for 18 months from 2020 to 2022 due to Covid and due to moving to a new location (from Kasernenstr. in the Altstadt to Mecumstr. in Bilk).

# 1 Total checkouts & patrons over time

The library has seen a continuous growth in total number of checkouts as well as distinct patrons over time.


## 1.1 History and growth from 2016 to 2025



## 2 Types of media and genres


Where do patrons check items out from? The following table and chart show the raw number of checkouts, demonstrating that half of our *checkouts* make up books from the Children's Area.

However, this is not representative of our patrons, as many patrons who take out children's books, take out 10-20 books at a time. In order to get a better picture of our patrons, we need to look at the unique number of patrons, rather than checkouts.


## 2.2 Number of patrons by shelving location

This chart counts distinct **patrons**, rather than the total number of checkouts. This illustrates only 17% of total distinct patrons make up patron checkouts from the Children's Area, while the vast majority check out Fiction, Non-Fiction and New Books.

## 2.3 Deep dive of number of patrons by genre

Shelving locations are not particularly useful in the analyses of our checkouts, as they are not representative of the collection and the genres (and they are not actively maintained). To get a better picture of which types of genres patrons really check out, the following analysis shows the library's genres, re-categorized into thematic clusters (distinct from shelving location).

The numbers represent the number of distinct *patrons* who check out these books, not the total number of checkouts.

### 2.3.1 What is the difference between the values?

**pct\_total\_patrons** uses the total patron count from the original data frame. In 2025, we had 610 unique patrons overall. If 435 of them ever borrowed a Fiction book, then Fiction's `pct_total_patrons` is  $435 / 610 = 71.3\%$ . This tells us how big the Fiction audience is compared to everyone who ever borrowed anything.

**fraction** uses the sum of the `num_patrons` (distinct number of patrons) values shown in the table. Because we first calculated distinct patrons by `genre_group`, a single patron can appear in multiple rows (if they borrowed books from several genres). So the sum of `num_patrons` is larger than the true total number of unique patrons. In the example, the sum of `num_patrons` is about 1,613 (because many patrons are counted more than once). The fraction for Fiction is  $435 / 1,613 = 27\%$ . This tells us the proportion of genre-specific patron counts that belong to Fiction, not the proportion of all unique patrons.

To summarize:

- `pct_total_patrons` = “How many of the library’s individual patrons love this genre?”
- `fraction` = “If we look at all the genre-patron connections (including duplicates), what slice does this genre occupy?”

Because patrons can belong to several genres, the two percentages will usually differ: `pct_total_patrons` adds up to 100 % across all patrons, while `fraction` adds up to 100% across all genre-patron pairs (which can exceed the number of unique patrons).

## 2.3.2 All genres, grouped

This table shows the above categories, split up into genres (ccode in Koha). It lists the distinct number of patrons who checked out items from this collection.



## 3 Junior Fiction

Junior Fiction makes up the majority of total checkouts - even though as we can see in the previous section, when taking into account all checkouts by distinct patrons, it is not our most popular genre. This is because the people who check out Junior Fiction, often check out a large amount of books at a time.


To get an idea of which types of Junior Fiction is most often checked out, we can look at the different age group categorizations.

Total number of checkouts by Junior Fiction subject




## 3.2 Percentage of patrons who check out Junior Fiction

When looking at distinct patrons instead of total checkouts, we can see that actually only 24% of all patrons who check out children's books, check out picture books.

To summarize both charts, 24% of patrons who checked out any Junior Fiction books, checked out over 3000 Picture books in 2025.



Audiobooks are declining in popularity steadily.





While the historical data is very interesting, when plotted we should only take into account the last few years for an accurate picture of membership growth. The library was closed for 18 months during covid and due to moving to a new location, hence there is a significant gap. Also, the library has only been using Koha to track memberships since 2016, therefore anything before that date does not represent active library memberships.

This plot visualizes the memberships by year and the action for 2022 - 2025. Expired includes only memberships that were *not renewed in the same year*.



To get a more accurate picture of membership loyalty and growth, we can remove the expired (non-renewed) memberships from the graph, and we can see that we've steadily gained new patrons in the past few years.
