ABOUT THE LIBRARY

The International English Library is the only public English library in North Rhine-Westphalia.

It was established in 1946 as a British Forces initiative to bridge the gap between nations previously at war. The Occupation Office created "Die Brücke", translated as "The Bridge", which hosted many cultural events, in addition to the library.

Together with the support of many loyal sponsors, the library remains the wonderful organization it is today, run entirely by volunteers from cultures all around the world!

We work closely with many local schools and educational facilities.

The library is managed by the non-profit association **Friends of the International Library e.V.** If you are interested in further supporting us, ask us about a Friends membership.

OUR COLLECTION

We have over 21,000 English-language publications, including:

- over 8100 fiction books, from classic to contemporary literature, crime, sci-fi, fantasy and graphic novels
- over 5200 non-fiction books
- over 4600 books for children of all ages, as well as a large selection of young adult books
- over 3400 DVDs (English and foreign-language movies and TV shows)
- current newspapers and magazines
